Captain James Cook Map Viewing At Admiralty House

Admiralty House, a nationally registered historic site, is located in Mount Pearl, NL. It was built in 1914 for the British Admiralty as a World War I communications post. It now houses a museum, with exhibits on the history of Mount Pearl, Guglielmo Marconi and wireless communications, the wreck of SS Florizel, and HMS Calypso (later HMS Briton); a training ship for the Newfoundland Royal Naval Reserve before and during World War I.
